Class Outline:

One Topic = 4 Classes (2 weeks)

Class 1 = Tuesday - Lecture Style in Class

Class 2 = Thursday - Lecture Questions and Research Time

Post = Upload (Post) **one writing** to your Online Discussion Forum Group (Due by Friday night 8pm) (I will edit this by Saturday 8pm)

Class 3 = Tuesday – Group Discussion Class (Discuss your Topic in your Group using your **one writing** as a guide)

Class 4= Thursday – Open Discussion Class on the Topic (all students and teacher)

Grading:

Attendance = 10%

You will lose 1% every time you are absent from class, unless you tell me in advance.

Class 1 = 10%

In Class 1, you will participate in a lecture about some aspect of European Popular Culture (Years 2000-2016). You can ask questions etc. to get a fuller understanding of the topic. You will be assigned a Group (3 to 4 students) at the end of this class.

Class 2 = 10%

In Class 2 you can ask your teacher and your classmates any questions you have about the previous Lecture (content, vocabulary etc....) You can also in this class begin your Research about the Topic, using your Smartphone, Computer or Tablet.

Post = 30%

You will need to upload one written post (between 1-100 words) to your Online Discussion Forum Group (Due by Friday night 8pm). Please check the **1st Post Rubric** on Moodle (to see the grades for this).

Class 3 = 20%

In your Group of 3 or 4 students, you will introduce and chat about your Research. This chat will be based on your one written post uploaded to your online Group Discussion Forum in Moodle.

Class 4 = 10%

As a whole class, we will wrap up and chat about the Topic. This chat will be based on everything you have done and researched in this Topic. I will also briefly introduce the next Topic in this class.

Final Exam = 10%

Week 16 – Group Presentation = 10%

On the Tuesday or Thursday in Week 16, you can give an 8 minute Group Presentation based on one of the Topics from our Course. (I would expect 4 people in a group, so about 2 minutes each or so...this presentation can be supported by visuals etc.)
