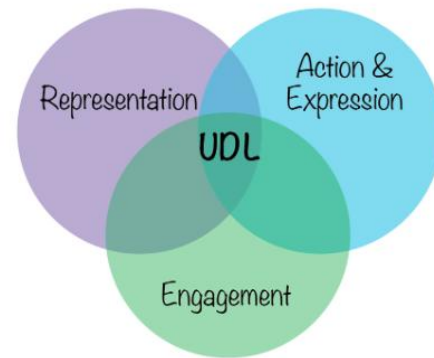


Universal Design for Learning (UDL) in This Course
